

SFTP Instructions using FileZilla (Windows Users)

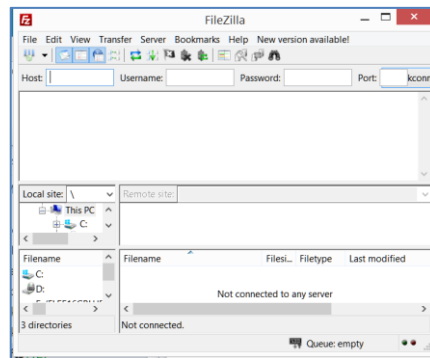
FileZilla is a free download FTP program that allows you to transfer files from your computer to another computer/server. It works on Windows, Mac OS X and Linux using FTP and SFTP.

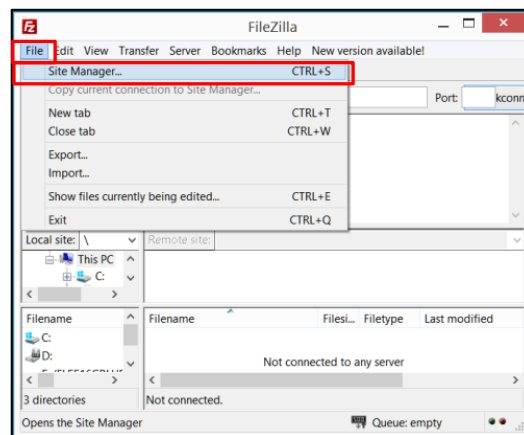
Click the above link to download FileZilla, follow the instructions in the download to install the FileZilla to your computer.

SFTP Step by step instructions:

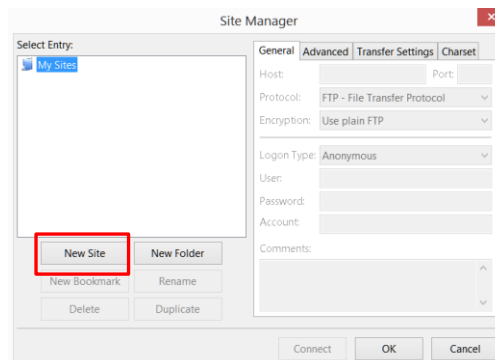
1. Open FileZilla, the following window will open.



2. Click on **File > Site Manager**



3. The **Site Manager** window will open. Click **New Site**



4. Fill in the fields illustrated below and click **Connect**

Host: st3w.ivc.edu

Port: 22

Rename the new site to **st3w.ivc.edu**

Protocol: Click the down arrow to select **SFTP – SSH file Transfer Protocol**

Logon type: Click the down arrow to select **Normal**

User: Is your IVC/Saddleback user name
Password: Is your student ID no
Not your PIN or password
E.g.: Username: flee3, Password: 201321

5. The following window will pop up, click **OK**

Site Manager - Cannot remember password

Saving of passwords has been disabled by you.
'Normal' and 'Account' logontypes are not available. Your entry has been changed to 'Ask for password'.

6. Reenter your password.

7. If you entered the fields correctly, you should login successfully and see the following window. **Double click to open fle folder.**

This section show that you have connected successfully.

This section is the local site, your computer or flash drive.

Navigate to your folders of files you want to upload.

This section is the remote site, st3w.ivc.edu

8. When the window opens, double click to open the CIM141_XXX folder, where XXX is the current semester.

9. Scroll down to find your folder. The name of your folder is same as your user name. E.g., fle3.

10. Navigate to your local drive, drag the folders or files that you want to upload from your local drive to your folder in the server.

11. After successfully transferring/copying the folders/files, you need to check your website on the internet.

12. Check your website on the internet:

- Open a browser, Google Chrome, Safari or another.
- Type in <http://st3w.ivc.edu/flee/> at the address bar. (Bookmark this site for convenience access.)
- Navigate to the current semester folder
- Select your name; you should see your electronic Portfolio with your name
